Update 19/03/2020

I write on behalf of the Directors and Academic Board of the Bible School. We recognise that these are unprecedented times and we are keen to keep communicating with you as much as possible in the coming days and weeks and to reassure you that you have our full support.

In the light of government directives concerning the Coronavirus, we have decided to close all meetings at the Bible School venues until further notice. The last set of lectures for this term were to take place on

Saturday, March 28th (1st, 2nd and 3rd years);

Tuesday 31st March (3rd years)

Saturday 4th April (Israel and the Church)

These lectures will no longer take place at the various halls/rooms usually designated for Bible school classes.

We are hoping to put on the student portal the materials and recordings for these last set of lectures so that students can listen to those lecture online as they would usually do through the student portal.

Peer Tutorials and One to One Meetings will now take place via WhatsApp or Skype for the time being. If your peer tutorial has not already taken place, your tutor will be in touch to arrange suitable times. One to ones will start in April and tutors will be in touch via WhatsApp. Students are expected to submit any assessments as per usual online via assessment@grace-city.org New deadlines will be communicated.
